HOPEWELL METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH

Was organized about 1830, at the house of Samuel Martin. It began with a very limited membership, consisting chiefly of the Martin family and Culwell Williamson. A hewed-log church, located about one and one-fourth miles northeast of Pharisburg, was built and served as the house of worship till the present frame building was erected. A protracted meeting was conducted by Rev. Longfellow about 1858, which resulted in a great increase of members. The church has since been weakened from a variety of causes, and at present there are no regular services. (History of Union Co., OH., Beers, 1883. reprint 1981, V. 2, P. 428)

CHRISTIAN OR "NEW LIGHT" CHURCH

In Hildreth's Schoolhouse, west of Pharisburg, a Christian, or "New Light" society was organized several years ago. Rev. Shirk held services there for some time, and Rev. Hurd has been preaching for several years. The society is gaining in strength. David Hildreth, Albert Gardner, Emanuel Shinnaman and Daniel Burkopile are members. A Sunday school is conducted during the summer. (Ibid, V.2, P. 428)

Hope you are all enjoying surfing the genealogy websites. I have found a few more that you may want to check out. Here is a fairly new one: <http://infinet.com/~dzimmerm.mohcoun1.html> It is called the Ohio County Information Page and has links to all kinds of information such as: Adoption. Early Ohio Settlers. Ohio State Maps. Libraries. and lots more. There is even a section for Free Genealogy Lookup Page, where you can add a query and perhaps someone looking for the same name will see it. Also on this page you can find a picture of our Union County Courthouse under Ohio County Courthouses. There is even a section on Tombstone Meanings and what links on there. I have that "bookmarked" so I can go back to it often.

Most of you have heard about the World Family Tree CDs that contain lots of surnames. You can find their home page at: <http://www.familytreemaker.com/> and The Online FamilyFinder Index has a total of 153 million names in it. There are also over 5000 links to different Genealogy sites. Lots of information at this site to link you to all kinds of genealogy information. You will want to bookmark this page also!

Don't forget to use the different search engines (ed. note: these usually denoted on your computer's opening internet screen, such as "Yahoo", etc.) To check out your surnames too? Never know when you might find a distant cousin who is also researching the same family tree.

If you have Eastman surname in your family tree, you'll have to check out Eastman Genealogy & History page at: <http://pw2.netcom.com~seven007.GeorgeEastman.html>. George Eastman currently has 35,088 names on his home page. He is always updating his page, and gives little sketches about some of his ancestors.

NEW BILL ADDS CEMETERIES TO LIST PROTECTED UNDER DESECRATION LAWS

Tipping headstones in Ohio's cemeteries will soon be eligible for the same punishment as burning the American flag. Ohio law currently contains a list of things including the flag, public monuments, and churches which people are prohibited from damaging under the desecration law. Vandalism of a cemetery is currently punishable as a felony charge, which carries a stiffer penalty. The bill adjusts legal la' guage so that vandalism and desecration laws include any place of burial including sites that contain American Indian burial objects placed with or containing American Indian remains. (The Marion Star, Columbus Bureau, May 23, 1998) It's about time!
